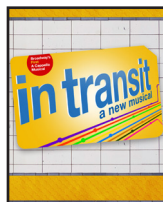




A Bronx Tale

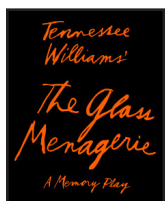

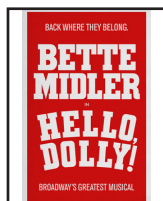
Miss Saigon

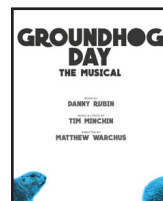
