

Gigi tells the story of a free-spirited teen-


age girl living in Paris who is groomed (in the custom of her family) to serve as a companion to a bored, wealthy playboy until the pair realize they have fallen in love.

Set in 1594, brothers Nick and Nigel Bot-


tom are desperate to write a hit play, but are stuck in the shadow of that Renaissance rockstar known as "The Bard."


