

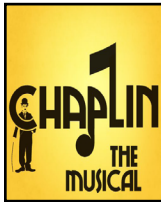

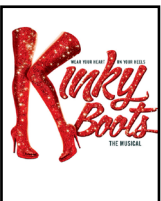
**Chaplin The Musical**
